Lighting Project at Holy Trinity: To misquote the third collect in the service of Evening Prayer: Our "Darkenss is about to be lightened!" New Lighting: LED lighting is to be installed in Holy Trinity commencing at 1400 on 03 September 2018 and the work is expected to take about 3 weeks. The Church will be closed during this work from Monday to Friday, for security and everyone's safety.
