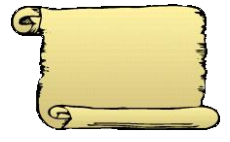

Lighting Project at Holy Trinity: To misquote the third collect in the service of Evening Prayer: Our "Darkness is about to be lightened!" The plans to replace Holy Trinity's lights with energy efficient LED's have been completed. The cost is just over £20,000 and generous grants have been received from the Friends of the Parish and Allchurches Trust Limited which is covering over half the cost. New Lighting : LED lighting is to be installed in Holy Trinity commencing at 1400 on 03 September 2018 and the work is expected to take about 3 weeks. The Church will be closed during this work from Monday to Friday, for security and everyone's safety. The Church will be open as usual on Sundays for services and Saturdays so that, for example, cleaners and flower arrangers can have access.

Wednesday evening services will continue normally as will Tuesday evening bell ringing practice. This work will be under the direction of Tim Herbert of H. J. Herbert [Electrical Engineers] Limited, Preston.
